Dear Parents/Carers

We are looking forward to welcoming your child into Year Three next term. School starts at the same time, 8:55am, with the school open from 8:45am to allow children to enter independently through the Year Three side door. School finishes at the slightly later time of 3:20pm and children will exit from the same side door by Year Three or through their class fire door. If you wish to speak to your teacher in the morning, please send a message via the office or speak to the member of staff on the Year Three door.

In Year Three many children become more independent and you may well ask your child to meet you at a different place on the playground or by the main school gate. Children will be reminded that if for any reason you are not there to meet them, they must go straight back to their class teacher. Any children not collected at the end of school will be taken to the school office to wait.

Early next term there will be an opportunity to meet your child's teacher where more specific information will be given regarding reading, curriculum, homework and daily routines. Reading takes a similar format to Year Two, children select their own levelled reading book and parents sign a reading diary to confirm that reading has taken place. We aim to issue a reading book at some point during the first week back. At break time, fruit is no longer provided in Key Stage Two so please pack a healthy snack for your child.

Classroom equipment will be provided but your child may bring in their own pencil case with basic resources if they wish. If so, please ensure they are small enough to fit into their school tray and they will be used at the discretion of their teacher.

Attached is a list of common, high frequency words from Key Stage One that your child should know ready for Year Three. As well as working through this list, it is always beneficial to keep practising the multiplication tables. We hope you have an enjoyable summer and we look forward to an exciting year to come.
